Family	Fabaceae (Leguminosae) Subfamily- Caesalpiniaceae
Plant description	The golden shower tree is a medium-sized tree, growing to 10–20 m tall with fast growth. The leaves are deciduous, 15–60 cm long, and pinnate with three to eight pairs of leaflets, each leaflet 7–21 cm long and 4–9 cm broad. Inflorescence -Pendulous racemes. Each flower with five yellow petals of equal size and shape. The fruit is a legume with a pungent odor and containing several seeds
Distribution	The species is native to the Indian subcontinent and adjacent regions of Southeast Asia.

Uses	Bark is used in the treatment of inflammatory swellings and as a cleaning agent for ulcers and wounds. It is believed to decrease purulent discharge and act as a local antiseptic. The fruits are also used as a laxative. The wood is used to make a good quality charcoal
