COURSE OBJECTIVES:

Hindi is one of India's official languages and is the fourth most spoken first language in the world. It is the lingua franca of a major section of the Indian population. Communication skills in Hindi are essential for everyone who travel or live outside Kerala for various purposes, whether it is for job, studies, business, entertainment, etc. Since more than a million of migrant workers from the North and North-east India are working in Kerala in various sectors, spoken proficiency in Hindi is essential these days even for those who reside in Kerala. Though Hindi is studied in Kerala even from the school level and speaking Hindi is quite comfortable for many, there are still a good number of students who need some additional support for mastering Hindi as a spoken language. The objective of the course is to train students in Spoken Hindi so that they master the day to day use of Hindi for essential communications.

Course Outcomes: At the end of the course, the students will be able to

1. Familiarize vowels and consonants in Hindi Language
2. Learn the Hindi words used in day to day life.
3. Engage in conversations in Hindi
4. Be fluent in the practice of speaking Hindi.

Course Syllabus: The Course is divided into 4 modules.

Module 1: Introducing Hindi Alphabet and pronunciations

Introducing Hindi Alphabet.

Familiarize vowels and consonants in Hindi Language.
Audio and video of pronunciations.

Module 2: Daily Life Vocabulary

Familiarize the words used in day to day life.

Name of days, months, and season. Name of fruits and vegetables. Name of food items, pulses and cereals. Name of animals, birds, flowers and trees.

Name of clothes, fibre, utensils, metal, ornaments etc. Name of diseases. Parts of body. Number from 1 to 100. Different measurements. Different actions in Hindi.

Module 3: Conversations

Conversations in Hindi. Understanding rules of singular and plural nouns in Hindi. Tense used in Hindi. Sentence Corrections.

Module 4: Listening and Speaking Practice

Listening the video of communication in Hindi. Speaking and practice. Test papers. Evaluations.

Eligibility: Any student of Mar Ivanios College (Autonomous) is eligible to join. Preference will be given to final year students.

Intake: Each batch will be limited to a maximum of 40 students.

Evaluation and Grading: There will be practical oral tests and examinations in Spoken Hindi during and at the end of the course. Grades will be awarded according to the marks obtained, as follows:
